AFGE Council 222 is proud to partner with the Bollinger Foundation in announcing to the HUD employee community the availability of the Foundation's need-based grants to assist children who have lost a parent or legal guardian.

Steven Bollinger was a former Assistant Secretary for Community Development at HUD. While serving in 1984, at the age of thirty-six, he passed away, leaving a young family with children. The Bollinger Foundation was established in his name.

The Bollinger Foundation provides financial assistance to children of any age who have (1) lost a parent or legal guardian, (2) at least one parent or legal guardian who works/worked in the housing, community development, or economic development field, and (3) demonstrated financial need.

The Foundation provides approximately \$100,000 in grants each year with grants generally ranging from \$4,000 to \$8,000. Grants are awarded based on families' financial needs.

The Bollinger Foundation primarily provides funds to help children's education, including but not limited to special educational needs, school materials, and college tuition. The Foundation also has awarded funds for counseling and other special needs, including needs arising from the Oklahoma City bombing of HUD.
