Dear Bargaining Unit Employees:

I am pleased to announce that negotiations for Supplement 32 "Implementation of the COVID-19 vaccination mandate and the HUD COVID-19 Response Return to Safe Workplace Plan" are now completed.

Supplement 32 protects the health and safety of bargaining unit employees across the country who are in CDC COVID-19 High community level status. Therefore, you are allowed to work Situational telework so that you are not endangered. The Supplement clearly states:

"Situational Telework: In any week when the CDC COVID-19 Community Level is at a High status for the county where the HUD office is located, the employee has the option to work Situational telework and it is voluntary to go into the HUD office. If the employee voluntarily works in the HUD office when the CDC COVID-19 Community Level is at a high status, the employee will follow the below masking protocols:"

There is no supervisory pre-approval. Entry into the workplace is optional.

I want to point out there are additional protocols that parties have agreed to which will provide the ultimate protection for health and safety.

As we continue these challenging times, please note that our Council of Union Locals will continue to guard your health and safety.
