Union Comment On Notice To Employees

All,

Many of you have wondered why HUD distributed a Notice to All Employees yesterday. The Federal Labor Relations Authority (FLRA) required HUD to send out the Notice by email and to post it on bulletin boards to settle a complaint of an unfair labor practice that the Union filed against HUD.

The Union had filed two complaints with the FLRA because HUD did not respond properly to the Union's request for information related to a proposed new Personnel Security and Suitability Policy handbook. Local 476 Steward Jerry Gross represented the Union in this matter, demonstrating to the FLRA why the information and documentation requested was essential. The FLRA required HUD to provide all available information and to distribute the Notice as HUD's public commitment to respond to Union requests for information in a timely manner in the future.

We expect another posting and email notice soon, relating to Employee and Labor Relations' refusal to negotiate proposals related to the Presidential Management Fellows Program. The Council continues to work hard to represent you, during a very difficult time.
