## DON'T BE FOOLED BY DECEPTIVE LABELS

## Dear Bargaining Unit Employee:

There is some confusion about the Union's position on the Office of Administration's recent emails regarding visioning sessions/future of work.

HUD Office of Administration is giving the false impression that the Union (AFGE Council 222 and constituent AFGE Locals) supports employees' attendance of these sessions.

Please be advised that the Union does not support employees' attendance of these sessions.

HUD is misleading AFGE bargaining unit employees and implying that the Union is a partner in their Visioning initiative by using labels such as "AFGE Session Registration Link."

The Union is OPPOSED to participating in these sessions because:

- HUD ignored our contract's provision for planning the "Workplace of the Future"
- HUD refused to work WITH the Union to plan for the future
- HUD will use ONLY the responses that serve MANAGEMENT's purposes
- HUD has refused to share information about the sessions with the Union
