SUBJECT: Elimination of Sign-in/out and the Establishment of Flexitour

- 1. The purpose of this supplement to the HUD/AFGE Agreement is to eliminate sign-in/out and flexitime in its current form and establish flexitour.
- 2. Employees will pre-select an arrival time within the flexible band of 7:00 a.m. 9:30 a.m., by submitting the appropriate form to the immediate supervisor. Arrival may vary up to one hour prior to or after the pre-scheduled arrival time.
- 3. The arrival time will remain in effect until a Work Schedule Request (form HUD-250017) change is submitted.
- 4. The supervisor may approve occasional variances from the pre-selected arrival time. A variance is defined as an employee's arrival time that is more than one hour before or after the pre-selected arrival time, but within the band as defined in paragraph 2.
- 5. Approval of a variance does not require modification of the established work schedule, provided that the eight-hour work day and core hour requirements are met. The adjusted arrival time (i.e., approved variance) will be annotated on the Work Schedule Request.
- 6. Employees on a flexitour are eligible to earn credit hours, within established limitations.
- 7. This supplement is effective within sixty (60) days from today.
