- 4. <u>Teleworking:</u> There shall be no adverse impact to the telework agreements of any employees as a result of this implementation.
- 5. <u>Reasonable Accommodation</u>: There shall be no adverse impact to any reasonable accommodation of any employee that may be affected by this implementation.
- 6. Work at Home: There shall be no adverse impact to any work at home agreement of any employee affected by this implementation.
- 7. <u>Leave:</u> Any leave previously approved shall not be rescinded as a result of this implementation.
- 8. <u>Bargaining Unit Status:</u> No employee shall be removed from the bargaining unit as a result of this implementation.
