SUBJECT: General Service Administration (GSA) Smoking Policy

SCOPE: The scope of this supplement encompasses impact and implementation of the GSA smoking policy affecting space occupied by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and under the jurisdiction, custody, or control of GSA.

- 1. <u>Smoke Free Environment</u>: HUD recognizes its responsibility to maintain a smoke-free environment for all employees.
- 2. <u>Designated Smoking Areas</u>: HUD agrees that all designated smoking areas will be in compliance with GSA FMR Bulletin 2009-B1. The Bulletin prohibits smoking in courtyards and within 25 feet of doorways and air intake ducts on outdoor space under GSA's jurisdiction, custody, or control.
- 3. <u>Smoking Cessation Counseling</u>: HUD offers counseling to smokers on a "voluntary" basis. The availability of smoking cessation counseling and/or programs will be posted on all HUD bulletin boards.

4. **Local Bargaining:** Local bargaining will be conducted regarding the impact and implementation of local issues within the scope of this supplement.
