NATIONAL SUPPLEMENT between DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT and AMERICAN FEDERATION OF GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES NATIONAL COUNCIL OF HUD LOCALS 222

SUBJECT: Reorganization of the Department's Contracting Functions

Scope: The scope of this Supplement encompasses the impact and implementation of the reorganization of the Department's contracting functions on the Office of the Chief Procurement Officer (OCPO) bargaining unit employees. This reorganization, occurring pursuant to HUD 2020, involves the placement of contracting responsibilities into the OCPO.

- 1. <u>Merit Staffing:</u> Management agrees to utilize merit staffing as the prime process for filling positions in the new organization.
- 2. Government Technical Representative (GTR) /Government Technical Monitor (GTM) Responsibilities: Management agrees that any OCPO employees appointed to GTR/GTM positions will have those duties documented in their elements and standards.
- 3. <u>Position Classification</u>: Management agrees that all OCPO positions will be graded at a level appropriate to their duties.
- 4. <u>Movement of Employees</u>: Management agrees to provide a list of employees who will be moved to a different work space as a result of the reorganization.
- 5. <u>Bargaining Unit Status:</u> Management agrees to comply with the law and the HUD/AFGE Agreement regarding bargaining unit status determinations associated with this reorganization. Management further agrees that the current number of bargaining unit positions will not decrease as a result of the implementation of the reorganization.

- 6. <u>Official Duties</u>: Management agrees that any duties employees are officially required to assume as a result of this reorganization will be appropriately classified and set forth in their position descriptions.
- 7. **Training:** OCPO Management agrees to establish a program to train and certify all employees assigned to GTR or GTM duties. The training will be adequate to allow these employees to perform their contract/monitoring oversight duties. The training and certification will be established in consultation with the union. Program area employees performing grant monitoring duties are not considered GTRs/GTMs for the purposes of this Supplement.
